Learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that as the impugned orders of recovery dated 08.02.2023 and 30.06.2023 (Annexures P/6 and P/6A) have been passed on the basis of the order passed by the Commissioner dated 04.05.2022, before which authority, the report of the second enquiry was sent and is pending consideration, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to avail an appropriate remedy of filing representation/appeal before the authority concerned so as to request the Commissioner to decide as to whether in view of the second enquiry report, any amount is liable to be paid by the petitioner or not.

3. Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl A.G, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case any report of the

vigilance is pending consideration before the Commissioner, an appropriate order will be passed by the authority concerned within a period of 08 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order so as to opine as to whether the petitioner is liable for recovery as being ordered vide impugned orders.

Keeping in view the above, as prayed for, present petition is disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
