The petitioners seek the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.109 dated 30.05.2023 under Section 61 (added later on) 68/1/14 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and 420 (added later on) and 120-B IPC at Police Station Ranjiv Avenue, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim orders dated 18.07.2023 and 18.10.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 18.07.2023 and 18.10.2023 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

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In this view of the matter, interim order dated 18.07.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
