The petitioner is alleging violation of the order dated 04.09.2018, passed by this Court in CWP-22260-2018, vide which, a direction was issued to the Municipal Council to take required action for removal of illegal encroachment, if any, expeditiously.

As per affidavit, filed by the Executive Officer, Municipal Council Urmur Tanda, Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, which is on record, it is stated that on verification at the spot, the only encroachment in the shape of stairs on the road was found and the same was removed in the year 2019 itself and there is no encroachment in terms of Section 172 of the Punjab Municipal Act, 1911.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law, if so advised.
