1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of letter dated 20.06.2023 (Annexure P-11) whereby application of the petitioner seeking inter zonal transfer from Northeast Frontier Railway to Northern Railway has not been considered being received after 13.03.2023.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent, during the course of hearing produced letter dated 09.10.2023 whereby respondent has extended attachment period of the petitioner for 6 months. He further submits that competent authority would consider claim of the petitioner, if fresh application is filed.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that his earlier application may also be noticed.

4. In the wake of statements of learned counsels for the parties, the present petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh application which would be considered by the respondents along with earlier application, in accordance with law.
