The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, praying for issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No. 2 to 5 not to unnecessarily harass the petitioner and not to interfere in the peaceful possession of the petitioner at the instance of respondents No. 6 to 13 by exceeding their powers as the dispute between the petitioner and respondents No. 6 to 13 is of civil nature regarding which civil litigation is already pending between the parties.

Keeping in view the vague contents of the petition and nature of the prayer made therein, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere in the matter.

Dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, in accordance with law.
