The prayer in the petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 31.07.2020 (Annexure P-4) whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender in case FIR No.19 dated 11.03.2020 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC registered at P.S. Ajitwal, District Moga.

On 08.08.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ *The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the order dated 31.07.2020 (Annexure P-4) whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender in case FIR No.19 dated 11.03.2020 under Section 420, 120-B IPC registered at P.S. Ajitwal, District Moga.*

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is ready and willing to come back to India and join

the proceedings.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner appearing before the Trial Court within a period of 04 weeks from today the operation of the order dated 31.07.2020 shall remain stayed.”

It has been brought to the notice of the Court that the petitioner has not complied with the aforementioned order as per which she was to come back to India to join proceedings.

In view of the above, I find no merit in the present petition and the same stands dismissed.
