1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to appoint petitioner on the post of peon on compassionate ground. In alternative, the petitioner is seeking direction to respondent authorities to decide his representation dated 22.08.2022 (Annexure P-7).
2. The father of the petitioner joined as peon in Central Bank of India, Sector-17 Chandigarh. The father of the petitioner passed away on 13.11.2018. The petitioner belongs to scheduled caste category and father of the petitioner was suffering from 75% disability. The petitioner has filed various representations to respondent seeking appointment as peon on compassionate ground.
3. Without commenting on merits of the case, the respondent No.3 is directed to look into representation dated 22.08.2022 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner and pass an order in accordance with law. The respondent No.3 shall pass order within 3 months from today after granting appropriate opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.
