At first call, a pass over was given to inform the Court of the stage of the proceedings before the trial Court. However, on second call none appears on behalf of the petitioner.

It is brought to the notice of the Court that as per status reflected on the e-Courts Portal, the petitioner had put in appearance before the trial Court on 04.02.2023 and filed an application for compounding of the offence. The said application, after due contest, has been disposed of in favour of the petitioner, vide order dated 07.08.2023.

The prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the complaint filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, summoning order dated 07.08.2023 and proclamation proceedings dated 17.08.2022, which orders have merged in the final order dated 07.08.2023.

The operative part of the said order reads as under:-

“Hence, the accused is hereby directed to immediately pay the complainant an amount of Rs.99,000/- as cheque amount and interest @ 6% comes to Rs.31680/-

till this month and Rs.9320/- on account of cost, which will come to Rs.1,40,000/- in total. However, complainant sought time of one day for receiving the payment. In case, complainant refused to accept the same, then the accused can deposit the same in court, which can be withdrawn by the complainant at any time.”

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous as such.
