Prayer made in the present writ petition was for seeking directions to the respondent No.2 to register FIR on the complaint of the petitioner against Sanjeev Sagar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Punjab Police, under Section 376 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 for committing rape on the petitioner and for transfer of investigation from the Special Investigation Team (SIT) constituted to any other Senior IPS Officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Khushpreet Kaur, Police Station State Crime, Member SIT, has informed today in Court that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous since FIR No.105 dated 03.10.2022 under Sections 376 and 506 of the

Indian Penal Code, 1860 already stands registered at Police Station, Urban Estate, Patiala. The investigation in the said FIR is being conducted by Special Investigation Team (SIT) comprising of Senior officers i.e. Mst. Nilambari Vijay Jagdale, (IPS), DIG, Cyber Crime, Punjab (Supervisory Officer); Smt. Darpan Ahluwalia (IPS), ASP, Derabassi, S.A.S. Nagar (Chairman); and Inspector Kailash Bahadur and Inspector Khushpreet Kaur, Police Station State Crime, Mohali that the investigation is nearing completion and a final report shall be filed on or before 30.11.2023.

The aforesaid statement made by the learned State counsel, on instructions, is accepted. The present petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, at this stage.

Let the final report on conclusion of the investigation be filed within the timelines as undertaken today in Court.

On filing of the final report, the petitioner shall be at liberty to pursue her rights in accordance with law, if any.

Pending, misc. application(s), if any shall also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
