1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner challenging the impugned order dated 30.03.2017 (Annexure P-7) vide which the claim of the petitioner for stepping up of pay has been rejected.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present petition, one Sh. Tejpal, who is junior to the petitioner, was getting higher salary as compared to the petitioner, which benefit has not been given to the petitioner and that too without any valid justification.

3. Upon notice of motion, the respondents have filed the reply saying that the claim of the petitioner in the present petition is for the grant of technical pay scale, which is not admissible to the petitioner keeping in view the fact that the petitioner was not having the required

technical qualification in order to get the said benefit of technical pay scale and even otherwise, the benefit of technical pay scale has already been withdrawn since the year 2014 by which Notification, it has already been mentioned that any employee, who has not got the benefit of technical pay scale, will not be given the said benefit and any employee who has got the benefit, the same will not be withdrawn, hence, Sh. Tejpal continued to get the benefit.

4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the Rule-4 by which, the technical pay scale were withdrawn with certain conditions.

5. Ordered accordingly.
