Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

2. On earlier occasion also, none came forward on behalf of the petitioner.

3. Short reply filed by way of affidavit of Mr. Kuldeep Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Malerkotla, District Malerkotla, dated 26.07.2023, is taken on record. Copy thereof be supplied to the opposite side during the course of the day.

Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

4. For reference, para No.6 of the aforesaid affidavit reads as under:-

“That from the inquiry conducted by the answering deponent i.e. Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Malerkotla and the statement of the petitioner

Narinder Kaur, it revealed that now the petitioners have no threat and nor they want to take police protection. So, no further action is required to be taken by the police....”

5. Perusal of the above extract clearly reveals that as on today, there is no threat to life and liberty of the petitioners.
6. In view of the above, present petition is disposed off.
7. However, it is clarified that that in case occasion so arises, petitioners would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy, as per law.
8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed off.
