1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners with effect the date, the services of similarly situated employees have been regularized in compliance of order dated 07.10.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-16056-2002.
2. The respondents are directed to consider the case of the petitioner for regularization in services against the post available i.e., 51, as is evident from the information provided under the RTI Act, 2005 vide letter dated 13.03.2018 and also in the light of judgment of similarly situated employees passed in CWP-27282-2015 titled as ***Satpal and Ors. vs. State of Haryana and Ors.***
3. Necessary orders be passed after that claim in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
4. In case, the petitioners are eligible for regularization, they will also be entitled to all the consequential benefits including seniority, pay scales and arrears of pay etc.
5. Petition in the aforesaid terms stands allowed.
