This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 23.06.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the present case pertains to the removal of respondent No.3 and tenure of the said respondent No.3 has lapsed and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and as such, the same be disposed of.
