Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the prayer of the petitioner in the present petition is for regularization of his services under the policies dated 18.06.2014/29.07.2011 (Annexure P/6 and P/7) issued by the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that nothing has been mentioned in the petition as to whether the petitioner fulfills all the requirements/conditions for regularization of his services as per the policies dated 18.06.2014/29.07.2011, copies of which have been appended with the present petition as Annexures P/6 and P/7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner objects to the said averments of the learned counsel for the respondents and submits that the petitioner fulfills all the requirements/conditions of the policies in question hence, the petitioner is entitled for consideration of his claim for regularization of his

services under the said policies Annexure P/6 and P/7.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioner files any representation with the respondents giving details as to how the petitioner is eligible for regularization of his services under the policies Annexure P/6 and P/7, the same will be considered and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an appropriate representation/claim will be filed with the respondents giving details of number of days for which the petitioner has worked in each year to prove that his claim is covered under the policies Annexures P/6 and P/7 and the respondents be directed to pass an appropriate speaking order hence, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
