The appellant has assailed the order dated 19.07.2022 passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide which the application under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure was dismissed in the case bearing FIR No.110 dated 30.03.2022, under Section 3(1) of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station B-Division, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the appellant contends that the aforesaid FIR has been quashed on the basis of compromise in terms of order dated 01.02.2023 passed in CRM-M-37346-2022 and consequently, the present appeal has been rendered infructuous.
