By means of this writ petition filed under Article 226 Constitution of India petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the order dated 28.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) passed by appellate authority, reversing the order dated 04.10.2018 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Maintenance Tribunal declaring transfer deed dated 15.09.2016 as null and void.
