HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner (Gaurav Sharma) has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking setting aside of award dated 07.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.1 – the Presiding Officer, Labour Court, Ambala. A further prayer has been made to direct the respondents to accommodate the petitioner on his job.

2. On the last date of hearing (04.12.2023), the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner and respondents No.2 to 5 are ad idem that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties for the lumpsum amount of Rs.50,000/-, in settlement of all the claims of the petitioner towards respondents No.2 to 5.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 5 submits that he may be granted an accommodation to bring the Demand Draft of Rs.50,000/- in the name of petitioner (Gaurav Sharma).

Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the parties, the matter is listed for further consideration on 13.12.2023.

Let the Demand Draft of Rs.50,000/- be brought by learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 5 in the Court on the next date of hearing.”

3. Today, learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 5 has brought a Demand Draft bearing No.021015 dated 11.12.2023, amounting to Rs.50,000/-, drawn in the name of petitioner-Gaurav Sharma, in Court. The original of said Demand Draft is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner in Court today itself, which is accepted by him, and a photocopy thereof is supplied in Court today, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that upon encashment of the aforesaid Demand Draft bearing No.021015 dated 11.12.2023, all claims of the petitioner against the respondents shall stand settled and nothing shall remain due against them.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the amicable settlement arrived at between the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of.

6. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
