HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present petition, the only question which survive is for the grant of financial ex-gratia benefits after the death of father of the petitioner-Head Constable Rajbir Singh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the dispute within the family has already been resolved so as to claim the benefit of ex-gratia financial benefits and appropriate application will be filed with the authorities concerned claiming the same and the authorities be directed to consider and decide the said claim in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Learned State counsel submits that in case any application is received for the release of the ex-gratia financial benefits in respect of the service rendered by Head Constable Rajbir Singh, appropriate decision will

be taken within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case any benefit is to be extended to the claimant, the same will be extended.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

5. Ordered accordingly.
