Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.208 dated 01.05.2022 under Sections 379-B and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa (Annexure P-1).

Vide order dated 21.09.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 21.09.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI, Suresh Kumar has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 21.09.2022 is made

absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
