Supplementary status report dated 15.11.2023 by way of affidavit of Narender Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bawal, District Rewari on behalf of respondent-State has been filed and same is taken on record.

2. On 14.07.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Prayer in this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.32, dated 06.02.2023, registered at Police Station Kasola, District Rewari, under Sections 147, 149, 427, 448 and 506 of IPC.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR and that he is being implicated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Kanwar Singh. It is further contended that co-accused Kanwar Singh besides Kaptan Singh has already been granted interim anticipatory bail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randhir Singh, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail petition by submitting that petitioner along with co-accused tried to take forcible possession of the plot in dispute belonging to the complainant.

It is revealed that co-accused Kanwar Singh, who is specifically named in the FIR, has already been granted the benefit of anticipatory bail, vide order dated 01.03.2023 passed in CRM-M-9622- 2023 (Annexure P-2). Another co-accused Kaptan Singh has also been granted the benefit of anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 17.03.2023 passed in CRM-M-13587-2023 (Annexure P-3).

Adjourned to 21.09.2023 for filing status report.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. He will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Today, on instructions, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 14.07.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 14.07.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
