The petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of direction to respondents to restore the consolidation watercourse by measurement of land for purpose of removal of encroachment which is dismantled and encroached again in Village Karor, Tehsil Sampla, District Rohtak.

This Court issued notice to the respondents and reply has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset has submitted that after filing of this petition, the respondent-State has redressed the majority of the grievances of the petitioner by consolidation of the watercourse and providing warabandhi. He submits that they have assured that if any grievance of the petitioner is remaining the same would also be redressed in accordance with law. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is satisfied with the conduct of the respondent-State and thus, does not want to press the present petition further. He has submitted that in case any grievance of the petitioner is left, he should be granted liberty to approach this Court.

Learned State counsel has submitted that reply has already been filed and the grievance of the petitioner has already been redressed.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the record, it is apparent that the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed by the respondent-State and thus, the petitioner does not wish to press the present petition further. The present petition is disposed of accordingly. However, liberty sought by the petitioner regarding approaching this Court again in case any of his grievance survives, is found to be genuine and he is granted liberty to approach this Court in case need so arises.
