VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the notice dated 09.09.2020, with a further prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no.2 to 6 not to interfere in the duties the petitioner and to allow the petitioner to work as a Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat, Jamarai.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Surinder Singh, Superintendent, Block Chola Sahib, District Tarn Taran, has pointed out that in the present case, Administrator has not been appointed and the Panchayat is carrying out the function with full coram and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect. Even on 12.10.2022, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.

5. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for recalling the order in case any cause survives.
