- 1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus praying for issuance of directions to the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners.
- 2. Learned State counsel has pointed out that even a representation has not been given to the competent authority.
- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action after giving a representation to the competent authority and after giving full and better particulars.
- 4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
