1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing of letter dated 13.06.2019 (Annexure P-3) and letter dated 24.06.2019 (Annexure P-4) issued by respondent No.2 in the form of a show cause notice.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Ms. Amandeep Kaur, DDPO, Patiala has submitted that after the passing of the said show cause notice, the petitioner was suspended and was thereafter reinstated and presently the petitioner is working as Sarpanch and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said fact.

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
5. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the case in case any cause survives.
