AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the light of the pleadings as have come forth, the petitioner would approach the Managing Director of Haryana State Industrial & Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (HSIIDC) by filing a detailed representation within a period of 10 days from today. He prays that some time may be fixed for giving a personal hearing to the petitioner through its representative and for finalization of the claim/representation of the petitioner within some specified time.

Learned counsel for the respondent has no objection to the prayer as has been made by the learned Senior counsel for the petitioner. He, however, contends that the original allottees as well as the representative of the petitioner-Company may come forth with a representation and should also participate in the personal hearing lest tomorrow any of the parties has any grievance in this regard.

He further contends that in case representation is submitted by the petitioner as

stated, within a period of 10 days, personal hearing would be given to the petitioner and the original allottees within a period of 15 days of such submission of the representation. Decision on hearing the petitioner would be taken within a period of six weeks of such personal hearing having been concluded. The decision so taken would also be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of one week thereafter.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of binding the parties to the statements given by the counsel for the parties.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
