1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the guidelines, qua the treatment of the accused while in custody, as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *D.K.Basu Vs. State of West Bengal [Writ Petition (Crl.) No.539 of 1986]*.

2. Compliance report dated 26.08.2023 by way of affidavit of Aman Yadav, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Crime, Faridabad, and reply dated 30.10.2023 by way of affidavit of Dr. Vinay Gupta, filed in the Registry, are taken on record.

3. Counsel for the State has pointed out that the petitioner has already filed CRM-M-33217-2023 with the allegations that he was given inhuman treatment by the police while in custody. However, vide order dated 01.09.2023 passed by this Court, the said petition has been dismissed as not pressed with liberty to the petitioner to avail the remedies in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition any more. Hence, the same is dismissed.
