The instant writ petition had been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to remove the kundi connections illegally installed on the transformer.

Learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 4 submits that Bankers Cheque for a sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) bearing No.114700 dated 19.07.2023, a photocopy whereof has been placed on record, is already ready and shall be deposited with the Registry of this Court during the course of the day. He further, on instructions from Mr. Jarnail Singh, LDC, posted at Sub-Div. Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur, submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous since the claim of the petitioner in the present petition was to direct respondents to remove the kundi connections illegally installed on the transformers of the petitioner by respondents No.5 and 6 and for taking appropriate legal action against the said respondents and that the said needful has already been done and the kundi connections installed by the said respondents have been removed and action as per the provisions of the

Electricity Act, 2003, has already been taken. A fine of Rs.34,088/- had been levied on the said respondents and the same stands deposited vide Book No.55375, Receipt No.231 dated 05.06.2023.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner pleads ignorance of the aforesaid developments.

Be that as it may, since a statement has been made at Bar by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents-PSPCL, there is no reason why the said statement be not accepted.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. The petitioner may seek revival of the present petition in case the aforesaid statement made on behalf of the respondents is found to be incorrect.

Pending misc. applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of accordingly.
