The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the FIR No.464 dated 10.08.2018 under Section 420 IPC registered with Police Station Kaithal City, District Kaithal on the basis of a compromise dated 07.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

On 28.10.2020, the following order was passed in this case:-

“The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

This is the second petition for quashing of FIR No.464 dated 10.08.2018 under Section 420 of IPC registered at Police Station Kaithal City, District Kaithal along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise deed dated 07.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

The first petition (CRM-M-32629-2020) was withdrawn on 14.10.2020 with liberty to file a fresh petition.

Counsel for the petitioner has referred to para 6 of the petition to submit that petitioner has not been declared as proclaimed offender in the present case.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Sidhu, DAG, Haryana, who is present through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Mr. R.S.Dhull, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2. He has admitted the factum of compromise effected between the parties.

The parties and Investigating Officer are directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court on 17.12.2020 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise. The Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court shall submit the report on or before the next date of hearing. The report be forwarded to this Court specifying the following:-

- 1. The number of accused arraigned in the FIR and how many have appeared before it and have made statements and whether any accused is absconding/P.O. in the case;*
- 2. the name of the complainant and injured/aggrieved and whether all of them have appeared and made their statements in support of the compromise;*
- 3. the stage of trial/proceedings;*
- 4. if the compromise is genuine, voluntary and out of free will of the parties.*
- 5. Whether any other criminal case is pending against the accused.*

Report of Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court be awaited for 11.02.2021.”

In furtherance of the compromise (Annexure P-2), none of the parties had appeared before the Trial Court in terms of its report dated

The learned counsel for the State, however, submits that a cancellation report was prepared on 04.11.2020.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
