Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to remove the illegal encroachment of the street done by the private respondent in shape of ramp which is causing danger to petitioner and his family members and every other person whosoever passes through it.

Vide order dated 14.07.2023, this Court had issued notice and the State was directed to file reply.

Status report filed by way of affidavit of Mr. Himanshu Aggarwal, Deputy Commissioner, Gurdaspur, is taken on record. It has been submitted by learned State counsel that for removing the encroachment, the BDPO had requested the Station House Officer, Police Station Kotli Surat Malli to provide the adequate police assistance to initiate the proceedings for removing the illegal encroachment.

Thereafter, the illegal encroachment has been removed in the presence of the Sarpanch, complainant and respected persons of the Village. The photographs of the place have also been appended. It has been submitted that the grievances of the petitioner have been duly redressed and thus, this petition is rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has endorsed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner. He submits that the encroachment has been removed and thus, he is satisfied with the action taken by the respondents.

After hearing counsel for the parties and the fact that the encroachment has already been removed, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
