On 20.01.2023, the following order was passed:-

“The petitioners prays for re-fixation of their pay after granting them the benefit of the policy of Assured Career Progression.

In response to the writ petition, the respondents while filing the reply, have asserted as under:-

“That in consonance with the instructions dated 01.01.2018 (Annexure R-1), due benefit of one increment on completion of 4, 9 and 14 years of service has been released to all the petitioners.

The learned counsel representing the the State of Punjab prays for a short adjournment to explain “As to whether the petitioners have been granted one increment each on completion of 4, 9 and 14 years of service or only one increment has been released for achieving the three different benchmarks?”

Adjourned to 27.01.2023.

To be listed in the urgent list.

No further request for an adjournment, written or oral, shall be entertained.

If the respondent-State fails to clarify the position, the Principal Secretary, Department of Animal Husbandry, Punjab, shall be required to be present in person, in the Court, on the next date of hearing.”

An additional affidavit of Director, Animal Husbandry Department, Punjab, has been filed explaining that the petitioners have been granted one increment each on completion of duration of 4 years, 9 years and 14 years, respectively.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the learned counsel representing the petitioners, on the basis of the aforesaid affidavit, submits that the writ petition is rendered infructuous and be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
