Petitioner has invoked writ jurisdiction of this Court seeking compassionate appointment owing to disability of his father, who was in employment of respondent No.4 in terms of resolution dated 24.03.2000 (Annexure P-1).

Respondent No.4 in his written statement has relied upon order passed by Assistant Registrar Co-operative Societies dated 16.05.2017 whereby the precise claim raised in the present writ petition has been dealt with and denied.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would not dispute that against the said order the petitioner has statutory remedies.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.

Needless to say the time consumed before this Court would not be counted towards delay in pursuing such remedy.
