Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.73 dated 02.06.2023, registered at Police Station Sri Anandpur Sahib, Rupnagar, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC.

Vide order dated 10.08.2023 passed by this Court, the arrest of the petitioner was stayed as the learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner is ready to settle the dispute with the complainant. On 29.08.2023, the case was again adjourned on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Today, at the outset, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Angrej Singh has submitted that the petitioner has not complied with the orders passed by this Court.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Since the orders passed by this Court have not been complied with by the petitioner, no relief can be granted to the petitioner as prayed for.
