“The petitioner through instant petition is seeking setting aside of order dated 20.03.2023 (Annexure P-1) whereby petitioner has been transferred without giving premature retirement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that petitioner applied for premature retirement on 13.05.2023. The application was filed after rejection of application of the petitioner seeking extension of stay. The petitioner has applied for premature retirement and does not want to join at new place of posting, however, department is pressuring to move to another place.
