Present writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 23.08.2022 passed by Assistant Collector, Grade-I-cum-Naib Tehsildar, Nathana, District Bathinda and order dated 13.02.2023 passed by Collector, Bathinda and order dated 28.03.2023 passed by Assistant Collector, Grade-I-cum-Naib Tehsildar, Nathana, District Bathinda and order/letter dated 26.04.2023 passed by Deputy Commissioner being illegal, wrong, erroneous and without opportunity of hearing.

It has been contended by learned counsel for respondent No.6 that the petitioner has already filed the ROR along with the stay application, which is now fixed for hearing before respondent No.1 on

11.09.2023. He submits that interim order was passed by this Court only to protect the petitioner from dispossession as the revision filed was not being heard, but the same is now fixed for hearing on 11.09.2023 along with the stay application.

Mr. P. K. S. Phoolka, Advocate has appeared and filed his vakalatnama on behalf of respondents No.7 and 8 today in the Court and the same is taken on record.

After hearing learned counsel for both the parties, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.1 to hear and decide the stay application of the petitioner which is already pending for adjudication before him on the date fixed i.e. 11.09.2023 in accordance with law. Till then , status quo be maintained by the parties.
