VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 07.07.2023 vide which the petitioner has been asked to vacate the house.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been able to lay his hands on the allotment order and other documents as well and thus, seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after annexing the said documents and making necessary averments.

3. Learned counsel for U. T. Chandigarh has relied upon a letter dated 21.02.2023 with respect to printing of a fake newspaper by the petitioner and her husband and also on letter dated 06.07.2023 issued by the

Department of Public Relations and also letter dated 06.07.2023 issued by Department of Public Relations to the Secretary, House Allotment Committee in which it has been informed that the petitioner is not associated with Aaj Samaj since March 2023. A copy of the said letters has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner. In case, the petitioner chooses to file a fresh petition, then the said three documents be also annexed with the writ petition.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

5. In case any such writ petition is filed, then this Court would consider the same independently, in accordance with law.
