1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of a direction to the official respondents to decide the representation/complaint dated 18.04.2023 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner and to register an FIR against respondents No.3 and 4 in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that a representation/complaint was given to the police against respondents No.3 and 4 as they have cheated the petitioner by taking an amount of Rs.15,00,000/- for the purpose of sending him abroad and thereafter respondents No.3 and 4 had rather issued a cheque to the petitioner but the same was dishonoured. He further submitted that in view of the above, necessary direction may be issued to the official respondents.

3. On the other hand, Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, Senior DAG, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Hardev Singh, submitted that a representation/complaint (Annexure P-3) which was filed by the petitioner has already been considered and after holding an inquiry, it was found that no offence has been committed by respondents No.3 and 4 and the said complaint has been consigned to records. He further submitted that the petitioner has already filed a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 against the private respondents No.3 and 4 with regard to the cheque which was dishonoured.

4. In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned State counsel and also in view of the fact that the only prayer made in the present petition is for seeking direction to the official respondents to decide the representation/complaint (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
