ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Seeking release of the detainee-Manpreet Kaur, the petitioner has come up before this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

2. Counsel for the State submits that copy of the petition has already been supplied to him and they have got instructions.

3. On instructions from HC Gurdev Singh, State counsel submits that they had inquired the matter and found that the alleged detainee has voluntarily left the company of the petitioner and one of the reason was that the petitioner did not take her abroad as was promised at the time of marriage.

4. Given the above statement, no further orders are required to pass in the present petition.

5. At this stage, petitioner's counsel seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to seek appropriate legal remedies in accordance with law.

6. Petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
