Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
Perused contents of the petition along with Annexures thereof.
Pleaded case is that both petitioners are major and it is their first marriage. Both are adults, wife 19 years old and husband about 30 years old and, thus fully capable and legally competent to take decision to choose their respective life partners. In the premise, petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, District Pathankot and Station House Officer, Police Station Taragarh, District Pathankot, respectively that the contents of the representation dated 10.07.2023 (Annexure P-5) seeking protection of life and liberty be duly verified. If warranted, requisite steps be taken, in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is clarified that this order shall neither be treated as a stamp of this Court *qua* marriage of the petitioners nor any reflection on the merits of the contentions raised by them in the present petition.
Present petition stands disposed of.
Keeping in view threat perception at the hands of private respondents, as contended by learned counsel, a copy of this order be given *dasti* under the signatures of Bench Secretary of the Court.
