SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

1. Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents No.4 to 6 not to harass or interfere in the peaceful live-in-relationship of the petitioners.

2. Concededly, petitioner No.2 was married with Mangal Singh. As per the averments made in the petition, she is in a live-in-relationship with petitioner No.1. Although, counsel for the petitioner, by making a reference to para 7 of the petition submits that a Panchayati divorce, has been taken, but he has neither been able to satisfy the Court regarding the legality of the Panchayati divorce nor has the same being placed on the record.

3. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to pursue the representation before the authorities.

4. Permission is granted.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
