Present petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short "Cr.P.C") for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents to complete investigation in FIR No. 346 dated 23.07.2022 registered under Sections 120-B and 420 IPC against respondents No.3 to 7 at Police Station Kheripul, District Faridabad.

2. Status report dated 02.12.2023 by way of affidavit of Sh. Devender Kumar, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Economic Offences Wing, Faridabad filed on behalf of respondents No.1 &2-State is taken on record.

Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

3. Para 3 of the aforesaid status report reads as under:-

"That after completion of all usual formalities of the investigation, challan/final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C was prepared on 05.10.2023 under section 420 IPC against accused Sumant Saini son of late Sh. Tej Singh, resident of House No. 206/3, Garhi Mohalla, Old Faridabad alone and submitted before the Ld. Illaqua Magistrate, Faridabad on 23.10.2023 for trial. Now the present case is pending in the Court of Ld. Judicial Magistrate Ist

Class, Faridabad for 15.01.2024 for appearance of accused and charge has not been framed so far. There are total 12 prosecution witnesses in the present case.”

4. Perusal of the above extract reveals that challan/report under Section 173 Cr.P.C has already been submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction on 23.10.2023 and now matter is stated to be pending for 15.01.2024.

5. In view of the above, no further direction is required to be issued in the matter.

6. Disposed off.

7. However, the learned trial Court shall proceed in the matter, expeditiously.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
