HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Present writ petition has been filed challenging the order dated 21.08.2017 (Annexure P-3) whereby the services of the petitioners were terminated as well as order dated 09.05.2018 (Annexure P-6) whereby the claim raised by the petitioners in pursuance to the order passed in CWP No.1452 of 2018, has also been rejected.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that services of the petitioners were terminated on the ground that they are no longer required whereas, work of the post against which the petitioners were discharging duties while in service still exist.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that after the termination of the services of the petitioners, certain persons have been employed on the same terms and conditions, which is totally arbitrary and illegal.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that even for the period when the petitioners discharged the services, their salary was not

released by the respondents, which ought to be released forthwith.

5. Last submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioners is that once the petitioners have worked with the respondents and there are enough post where the petitioners can be adjusted, the respondents may be directed to consider the claim of the petitioners for adjustment under the Swachh Bharat Mission.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any grievance is raised by the petitioners by filing appropriate representation giving the details as to how the work of the post on which the petitioners were working exist and somebody else were appointed in the place of the petitioners or the petitioners can be accommodated on any other post, the said request will be considered with open mind and appropriate order on the said representation will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case any merit is found in the claim of the petitioners, appropriate relief will be given to the petitioners within a further period of four weeks or any salary is pending with the Department to be paid to the petitioners, the same will be paid.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate representation with the respondents.

8. Ordered accordingly.
