The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct respondent no.2 to ensure that the petitioner is permitted to join on the promotional post of Punjabi Master.

On 02.02.2016, the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion, returnable by 4.3.2016.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Puneet Kaur Sekhon, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service on them. Mr. Budhladwale to supply six sets of the paper-book to Ms. Sekhon during the course of the day.

In the meantime, an interim mandamus is issued to the respondents to find a solution to the predicament of the petitioner at an appropriate station following his promotion.”

In the written statement, the respondent-State has stated that the petitioner has joined as Master at Government Middle School, Nathpura (Bathinda) on 15.03.2017.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner admits that the petitioner has been permitted to join on the promotional post on 15.03.2017.

He further submits that in view of the statement made by the learned counsel representing the State of Punjab, the writ petition is rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
