Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR
No.156 dated 16.7.2022 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police
Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

The allegations in nut-shell are that petitioner and co-accused
Manoj Kumar lured the complainant on the pretext of providing him
government job and then complainant paid Rs.7 lac to co-accused Manoj
Kumar and made another payment of Rs.25,000/- to the petitioner. But the

accused persons failed to provide any job to the complainant and have not returned the aforesaid amount to him.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined investigation with the police in compliance of order of interim bail passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the petitioner and submits that the petitioner is not required by police for further investigation or for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order dated 8.8.2022 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
