1. The writ petition is filed in the nature of Certiorari seeking quashing of order passed by District Controller Food, Civil Supply and Consumer Affairs, Tarn Taran, (for short 'DESC') suspending the supply of Tarn Taran essential commodities/food grains to Depot of petitioner.
2. The brief facts are that the petitioner-Sarabjeet Singh was allotted Depot. An inquiry was conducted against him and the licence of the petitioner was suspended. Aggrieved of that, the present petition has been filed.
3. Learned State counsel appearing on advance notice submits that the order is challenged on the ground that DFSC had no jurisdiction to pass orders. He produced notification dated 5th January, 2023 amending the Punjab Targeted Public Distribution System (Licensing and Control) order, 2016, whereby word "District Magistrate" has been substituted with "Licensing Authority". He further on instructions submits that in view of amendment the orders passed by DFSC suspending the supply to the depot of petitioner has been revoked and liberty is sought to pass a fresh order if

need so arises.

4. In view of statement made by learned State counsel, the petition is disposed of
5. Needless to say that the respondents would be at liberty to proceed in accordance with law.
6. Since the main case has been disposed of, pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
