This is an application filed by the applicant under Section 11 (6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short, ‘the Act’) seeking appointment of an Arbitrator by invoking clause 25 of the agreement entered into between the parties, as in spite of issuance of a notice by the applicant on 19.05.2022, Arbitrator has not been appointed.

On 12.05.2023, this Court proposed to appoint Justice Ajay Tewari, a former Judge of this Court, as the Arbitrator, to which learned counsel for the parties did not object. Necessary declaration, as required under Section 12 (5) of the Act, has been received.

In these circumstances, Justice Ajay Tewari, a former Judge of this Court, is appointed as sole Arbitrator to adjudicate the dispute(s) between the parties.

Application stands disposed of.
