By way of present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners are seeking issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Senior DAG., Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

As per petitioners, they have married against the wishes of respondents No. 4 to 6 who happen to be the relatives of petitioner No.1 i.e. Janvi Bains.

Both the petitioners claim themselves to be major stating that petitioner No.1-Janvi Bains is 09.08.2002 born and petitioner No.2-Akash Banga is 21.08.2000 born as per Annexures P-1 and P-2. Without commenting on the legality and validity of the marriage, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, S.B.S. Nagar to consider the representation dated 07.07.2023 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioners.

Keeping in view the fact that both the petitioners claim to have married, I think that if possible, respondent No.2 may call a meeting of the petitioners as well as respondents No. 4 to 6 in his presence, so that the parties get rid off their ill feelings and live amicably.

The petition stands disposed off.
