1. Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents not to replace the petitioner, who is employed as a Tubewell Pump Operator, by another set of temporary employees.

2. Pursuant to notice issued by this Court, a reply has been filed on behalf of the official respondents, wherein, it has been submitted as under:-

“2. That the petitioner is not going to be replaced with any other contractual employee. Therefore no cause of action accrued to the petitioner to file this writ petition. It is only in his mind that he will be going to be replaced, whereas there is no such move.”

3. In view of the stand taken by the official respondents, writ petition is disposed of.
