1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondent authorities to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

2. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioners has submitted that for the grievances raised by the petitioners in the present writ petition, the petitioners have given a representation dated 06.06.2023 (Annexure P-8) to the Superintendent of Police, District Yamuna Nagar and they would be satisfied in case respondent No.3 is directed to look into the said representation on the limited aspect of protection of life and liberty and to take appropriate action therefrom. It is further submitted that with respect to other reliefs, which have been prayed in the present petition, the petitioners be permitted to avail other alternative remedies in accordance

with law.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the respondents-State have no objection to the said course of action.

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 06.06.2023 (Annexure P-8) on the aspect of protection of life and liberty and to take appropriate action in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible. With respect to other reliefs prayed in the present writ petition, it would be open to the petitioners to avail alternative remedies in accordance with law.
