1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.158 dated 24.05.2023 registered under Sections 306, 34 and 506 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Kaithal, District Kaithal.
2. Status report by way of affidavit dated 20.09.2023 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarters Kaithal, submitted by the learned State counsel in the Court, is taken on record.
3. Vide order dated 14.07.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench, ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 14.07.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amit Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.
6. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
7. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.07.2023 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
