SANJEEV PRAKASH SHARMA, J (ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the petitioner for promotion to the post of Anganwadi worker.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed an appeal to the Director, Social Security and Women and Child Development, Punjab with regard to her grievances for not considering her case for promotion while other persons have been granted promotion.
3. I have considered the submissions made by the learned counsel.
4. Considering the provisions of the Rules framed by the Department relating to Anganwadi workers, it is deemed appropriate to direct respondent No.2-Director, Social Security and Women and Child Development, Punjab, to decide the appeal of the petitioner expeditiously and preferably, within a period of one month from today.
5. With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.
